MSCC GENERAL AND EXECUTIVE MEETING MINUTES January 2, 2008

Derek Watkins called the meeting to order at 7:56 PM at Warrilow's in Ferndale. Members in attendance were Bill Siess, Judy Siess, Tony Buglione, Ann Marie Buglione, Dave Rodier, Roger Campbell, Dmitriy Martynov, Derek Watkins, and Rick Bohn.

MINUTES: In the December minutes, a Corvair should be a Cosworth Vega. Judy S. moved to approve the minutes as ammended, Tony B. seconded, all approved.

MEMBERSHIP: Judy reported we have 15 paid members. Judy stated that since the Pin went on the Internet, the Pin does not inspire members to renew membership anymore. If the person doesn't read the Pin Online, then the person doesn't see the reminder below:

NOTICE: The 2007 dues expired October 31, 2007. The 2008 dues are due.

We did not have a drawing for the coveted mylar badge.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Our bank balance is OK.

EVENTS: The holiday party went well. The next event is the annual banquet. Judy is looking at March 15. She will research locations. If any active member has a conflict, contact Judy. Judy needs door prizes for the banquet. Everyone who comes to the banquet gets a goody bag with door prizes. Business that donate door prizes will get 3 months of advertising in our newsletter. Call Judy if you want to donate door prizes.

Derek handed out a proposed autocross schedule for 2008. Bill S. has concerns with the autocross school being a test and tune session for a small number of people. We need people to work the course, people to teach the new drivers, and new drivers interested in learning how to autocross. Tony suggested making the first event a test and tune rather than a school. We could get more people. If the Belle Isle lot is big enough, we could have different exercises in different parts of the lot. We could have a straight line slalom, a figure eight, and a triangle as exercises. Bill S. pointed out that Great Lakes Crossing required \$2 Million coverage, which has a higher premium than \$1 Million coverage. We can easily raise coverage, but not lower coverage. Derek said we need events in the middle of the summer in order to fill voids in the schedule. The other clubs may not schedule Champ events in July, August, or September. We might be able to schedule 5 events, anyway. Roger moved, Dmitriy seconded, all approved the schedule of events at Belle Isle. We will not schedule events at Great Lakes Crossing yet.

OLD BUSINESS: Judy researched insurance costs for a RallyCross. The rate is about the same as an Auto Cross. Derek will look into the Fowlerville Fairgrounds. The Detroit Region SCCA has about 1 RallyCross event per month, so we would need to coordinate schedules. We need a good turnout in order to make it viable.

Judy researched the cost of new business cards. The price is lower than the price that Brian was quoted. Rick moved, Bill S. seconded, all approved.

Bill S. researched the price of cone style trophies versus more traditional style trophies. The cone style are more expensive and require a long lead time, but are well received. We have to

order about 144, which lasts about 3 years. Roger moved to purchase the cones, Rick seconded, all approved.

Rick mailed the annual reports for continuing the incorporation of the club. The State of Michigan confirmed the payment, so the club is incorporated.

NEW BUSINESS: Bill S. stated the trailer plates are in the club's name. The registration is inside the door.

COUNCIL REPORT: No report.

SELL AND SWAP: None

Whenever people renew their membership, they will need to go to the Web site to read the current Gudgeon Pin, They will not receive anything in the mail. It's too expensive to send notifications of elapsed dues and receipts of paid dues. Receipts will be given out the next time the payor and payee are together.
